Student Council Leadership Positions & Requirements

Junior & Senior officers will mentor Freshman & Sophomore officers for the following leadership roles:

President -

The duties of the president shall be:

- · Serve as head of the Executive Council and ensure that the agenda is followed
- · Nominate committee leaders when necessary
- · Call special meetings as needed
- Stay in regular contact with Student Council/Class Sponsors

Vice-President -

The duties of the vice-president shall be:

- · Assume presidential role in the absence of the president
- · Keep order and help uphold the guidelines of the constitution
- Ensure that Student Council proceedings are running effectively
- · Recruit and guide current Student Council members

Secretary -

The duties of the secretary shall be:

- · Create and distribute an agenda for each meeting
- · Review and record official meeting minutes and voting results
- · Record and keep attendance of Student Council meetings

Treasurer –

The duties of the treasurer shall be:

- · Give a financial report at each meeting on Student Council (at large) and grade level accounts
- · Advise Student Council on matters of fundraising and use of funds
- · Sign off on all paperwork associated with the Student Council (at large) account

Reporter –

The duties of the reporter shall be:

- · Review and report on previous meeting's minutes
- · Report progress made on Student Council goals, activities, and events
- · Educate members regarding the rules of order at meetings

Student Council Eligibility Requirements

- 1. Must be enrolled in classes sufficient to earn at least 6 credits in a school year
- 2. Must maintain at least a 70 average in all classes
- 3. Must have no major disciplinary referrals on file and abide by all school rules
- 4. Must acquire the signatures of at least 4 faculty members who support your membership AND your grade-level principal's signature
- 5. Must reflect a positive image throughout all classes and activities at Hendrickson High School
- 6. Must regularly attend Student Council meetings

Penalties if Requirements Are Not Met

- 1. If academic requirements are not met, member is suspended from Student Council for the following three weeks grade reporting period.
- 2. If there is an academic deficiency in any subsequent grading period, the member will be removed subject to administrative review.
- 3. If member receives a disciplinary referral, he/she may be temporarily suspended or removed from office. Action is subject to administrative review and hearing.
